- Since January 2012, 16 Serious Incident (SI) cases have been declared to the PCT:

 - SI24751 WGH Norovirus Ward Closures
 - SI24650 Grade 3 HAPU
 - SI24955 SACH Patient Fall
 - SI25106 HHGH Norovirus Ward Closures
 - SI25715 Grade 3 HAPU
 - SI25648 Grade 4 HAPU
 - SI25669 Grade 3 HAPU
 - SI25720 Grade 3 HAPU
 - SI25757 Maternal Death
 - SI24326 Grade 3 HAPUs
 - SI24332 Grade 3 HAPU
 - SI65206 Grade 2 HAPU
 - SI26153 HCT/WHHT C-Diff death
 - SI26218 19.3.12 Maternity Closure
- 47 SI cases are progressing through various stages of investigation. Of these:
 - 10 from 2010/11 and 37 for 2011/12
 - 18 SIs are being put through the closure process
- 8 SIs require the submission of evidence of action plan implementation once the actions are complete in order to be considered for closure by the PCT.
