This visit was part of a nation-wide review of the termination of pregnancy pathway, with a specific focus on the consent process. The assessor asked to see sets of notes for women who had been through the process and those who were

awaiting the process.

The Trust service is specific to fetal abnormality. Other forms of termination (eg social) are managed through the primary

care service.

The assessor has not provided any formal feedback although

some informal points raised will be reviewed.
